

Free Wireless Access @ Marple Public Library



What do I need to get on?

To use the library's wireless access points, you need a laptop equipped with an 802.11b or 802.11g wireless network card.

How do I get connected?

Turn off the popup blocker on your computer (It may also be necessary to disable any VPN, proxy or firewall software).

Locate available wireless access points – Marple Library Adult Area or Marple Library Children's Area – and select one.

Login in using the following username and password:

guest
library

Read and accept the terms of the Acceptable Use Policy.

Start surfing.

Can I print?

There is no printing capability from the wireless network, but printing is an option if you use one of the library's internet or lab computers. Sign up at the reference desk to get on a computer and pay for all print jobs at the circulation desk.

Can I use subscription databases and downloadable audiobooks?

Go to www.marplepubliclibrary.org. You will need your library card to access the databases and to download books or to access your account information via the catalog.

Can a librarian configure my computer for me?
